Groundwork – What Should Our View of Evangelism Be?

While we may believe that part of living out our faith is sharing our faith with others, there are tensions that arise at the thought of discussing spiritual matters:

- We don't want to offend anyone.
- We don't want to seem out of touch.
- We don't know what to say.
- We don't want to be embarrassed.
- We don't want to get in trouble.

By approaching evangelism relationally before informationally, we will not only alleviate some of these tensions, but probably be more helpful to those we hope to influence.
